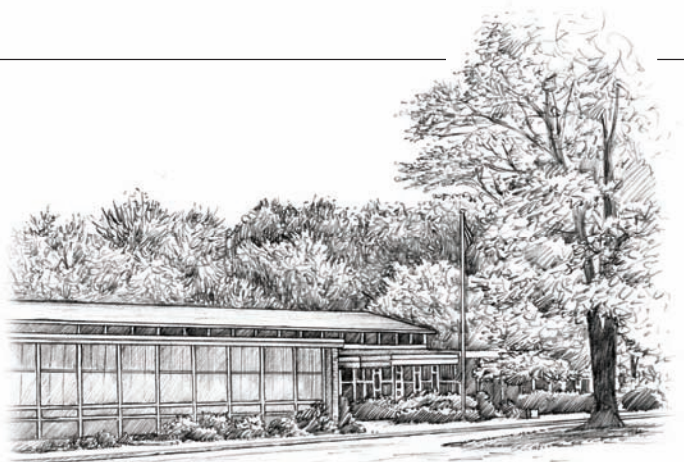

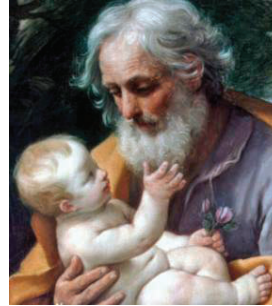

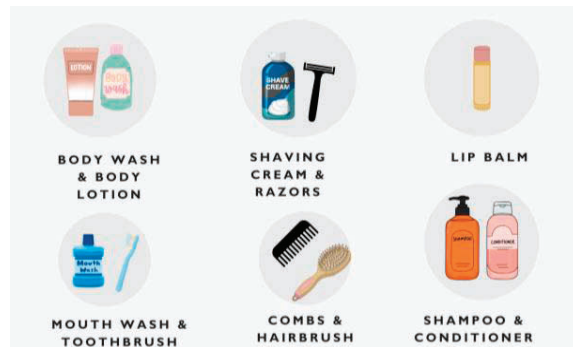

## HIS WORD TODAY

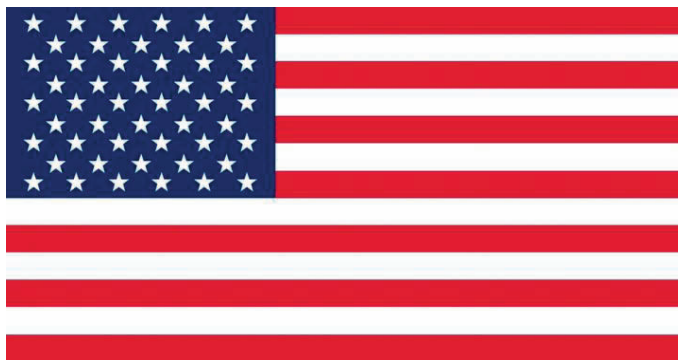

“At the sight of the crowd, Jesus’ heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, ‘The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest.’”

Jesus not only spent time among the people, but He also observed what was happening to them. He responded. Notice what motivated His response, pity and compassion. It is interesting to note to remedy the situation, He suggested that the disciples act in their behalf, we might say ‘all hands-on deck.’ The Lord is serious and asks if we are.

As we observe the lack of priestly and diaconal, or religious vocations to serve, it is time we find committed baptized to use their gifts for the Lord. How many are being called, but are deaf or preoccupied with themselves, not their salvation. While many people are trying to advance in their chosen profession, if the Lord has a meaning in their lives, there should be time and there are possibilities to make great contributions to the cause. We see lay missionaries giving a year or two for service, our parish communities look for catechists, home visitors, liturgical ministers even for people to clean or dust the church. What would it be like if only one half of those who are active were unable to continue to serve?

It is the Lord asking us to ask, or even better, to act.



## Today is Flag Day

Flag Day, in the United States, a day honoring the national flag, observed on June 14. The holiday commemorates the date in 1777 when the United States approved the design for its first national flag. The idea to set aside a day to honor the national flag came from several sources. Bernard J. Cigrand, a Wisconsin schoolteacher, in 1885 urged his students to observe June 14 as “Flag Birthday.” He later wrote an essay published in a Chicago newspaper that urged Americans to proclaim this date as the day to celebrate the flag. In 1888 William T. Kerr of Pennsylvania founded the American Flag Day Association of Western Pennsylvania, an organization to which he dedicated his life. A lesser-known claim is that of George Morris of Connecticut, who is said to have organized the first formal celebration of the day in Hartford in 1861.

In 1916 Pres. Woodrow Wilson proclaimed June 14 as the official date for Flag Day, and in 1949 the U.S.

Congress permanently established the date as National Flag Day. Although Flag Day is not an official federal holiday, Pennsylvania celebrates the day as a state holiday. Each year the U.S. president delivers an address that proclaims the week of June 14 as National Flag Week, and all Americans are encouraged to fly U.S. flags during that week.

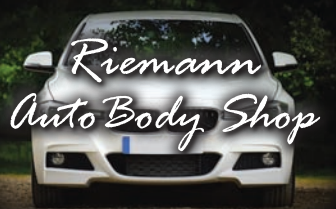
